JOSHUA CHAPTER 1

Joshua's Great Commission: Teaching for New Leaders / Teachers

- vs 1 God did not speak to Joshua as <u>Leader</u> until <u>after</u> Moses' death so Moses was <u>NOT</u> retired!

 In the Hebrew this book begins with 'And' (ve) showing its connection to the Pentateuch there is no break in the History of Salvation.
- The first 4 Books of Pentateuch: Gen / Ex / Lev / Numbers (FIRST SECTION of the Bible) all deal with Israel <u>OUTSIDE</u> of the Promised Land.
 - The next 8 Books: Joshua, Judges, 1 & 2 Samuel, 1 & 2 Kgs, 1 & 2 Chronicles form the <u>SECOND SECTION</u> of the Bible
 - Deuteronomy fits this section
 - all of these deal with Israel (in) the Promised Land.
 - Deuteronomy reminds them of their previous history <u>and</u> the lessons they must learn from it. It also proclaims <u>THE LAW</u> as the Rule for Chosen People.
- **Note** The death of Moses was a big blow to the Chosen People. He was the only leader they knew.
 - They knew the power of his intercession with God.
 - They witnessed his miracle-working powers.
 - On the human level they never needed him more than now to reach the goal of their journey through the wilderness and to take possession of their inheritance.
 - Without much military experience they had to take on seven "nations" in Canaan. cf Acts: 13:19 They had plenty to think about as they mourned Moses for 30 days: Deut 34:10
- vs 2 Joshua is a very new leader when God tells him it is time to <u>cross the Jordan</u> yet Moses had been a very new leader when God sent <u>him</u> to Egypt to take on the Pharaoh, the most famous and powerful world leader at that time.
- VIP It's not your youth or inexperience that God looks for. No! It's your <u>obedience</u> to Him and your surrender to His Divine Will. He can accomplish anything on Earth if He even has <u>ONE</u> person totally surrendered to Him. cf 1 Timothy 4:12; 1 Corinthians 1:27

 'Nothing is impossible with God'Mark 9:23; Luke 1:37; Matthew 18:26; Jeremiah 32:17; Genesis 18:14; Job 42:2; Romans 8:31
- <u>VIP</u> The death of a great person leader or saint does not <u>BLOCK</u> God's work! God is not tied to <u>ANY</u> instrument. His work spans <u>all</u> History and He can use anyone He chooses, for whatever reason He wants. He is Lord!
- <u>VIP</u> God's priority is to save as many as possible from <u>EVERY</u> generation: 1 Tim 2:4
 - Don't miss the point that Joshua did not push himself forward and 'take the reins' immediately after Moses' death. A <u>LESSER</u> person would have done that. No! Joshua waited until <u>God</u> gave <u>the order</u> for him to move. He had been trained under a good Master (Moses) and therefore knew the importance of **WAITING ON GOD**: Is 40:31, 30:18 / Ps 27:14
 - 1:2 It was Moses' <u>DEATH</u> that was the <u>Appointed Time</u> to enter and take possession of the land.
 - it is at this crucial moment that God assures Joshua that He will continue to be good to His Chosen People **And** He will **KEEP** His promises to them.
 - Notice "you and all of this people with you" vs 2
 - 1:3 "Every place you tread with the soles of your feet, I will give to you"

Sitting back and "waiting for God to work miracles" on their behalf was **NOT** going to get them the Promised Land... only those parts they **CLAIMED** by their own action! (cf Deut 34:2, 3)

- so it is spiritually! Our Christian inheritance is given to us by Jesus **yet** only what you conquer will be yours!
- <u>2 Cor 10:4-5</u> Rom 8:37: Those who won't "fight the good fight" don't win the prize: 1 Tim 6:12; 1 Jn 2:13; 4:4; 5:5; Rev 2:7, 17, 26; 3:5, 12, 21; 12:11

(NB) This journey of faith to the Promised Land began with Abraham: Heb 11:8-10

He **obeyed** the call of God and set out on the journey of Faith to a land which was promised him by God – hence its name: Promised Land. cf Gen 12:1-Abraham had to separate himself from the pagan world around him and put his trust in God beyond reason to reach his destiny... cf Romans ch 4; 2 Cor 6:14 - 2 Cor 7:4f Abraham became the father (origin) of all those who believe.

The journey is one of obedience to God's Will.

VIP Jesus showed us that some people **say** they will go... but don't: Mt 21:30 We need great discernment with people – things are **NOT** what they **seem...**

- Now we the descendants of Abraham must walk in his footsteps TO EXPERIENCE God's Goodness to them... and <u>understand</u> God's choice of them... and co-operate with God.
- They will not come into **REST** until Canaan is conquered. Deut 12:9 / Heb 3:7 4:11 We will see later that Israel did not **experience** the **REST** offered by God.
- Many Christians do not enter into the **REST** of Union with God either.

Mt 11:28-30: "I will give you rest... But shoulder my yoke"! (cf Mat 11:28-30)

Why is this? Eph 6:12 our enemies are NOT flesh and blood...

- We are opposed by the "world, flesh and devil" all trying to pull us away from our Union with God... so we must **overcome** the world, flesh and devil: **1 John** (please study 1:John!)
- This victory is **not** won easily: **Ex 23:29-30**... its little by little / sip by sip... because we must "Possess our possessions". We must **consolidate** or victories. cf Obadiah vs 17. Mt 12:43-45 \rightarrow demons return to unoccupied places.
- (NB) This constant battle to achieve Final victory keeps us DEPENDENT on God for we must be weaned off **SELF**- reliance.
 - Also our souls must be built-up and made ready for the big battles ahead...

Before we begin - Divine Assurance

OUR CHARTER FOR THE FUTURE

- faithfulness 1:6 Be strong and stand firm... for you are the man... to the 1:7 Keep the WHOLE Law... never swerve to the left or right The Law (the Divine Will) must be always in your life... meditate on it... | Word of God 1:8 1:9 THEN you will prosper... Be fearless, confident, go where you will
- **BECAUSE the Lord your God is with you!**

GOD's AGENDA

- **So** (i) All that Moses did was **FOUNDATIONAL** to what Joshua could do.
 - (ii) God's order was to be set up and maintained if God's help was to continue: Lk 1:73-75 (Benedictus)

For us: We are more privileged than them: the Law is written on our hearts. Heb 8:10; Jer 31:31-34 Jesus is **our** model and example: 1 Pet 2:21 Jesus is the Word Incarnate: He is the Law in human flesh... He fulfilled it perfectly. We are under the **Law of Christ**: 1 Cor 9:21

1:5 "I will be with you AS I WAS WITH MOSES... I will NOT leave you, nor forsake you" (Jer 1:19) God speaks to Joshua here – **NOT** just as a private person – but as **the LEADER** of God's Chosen People the instructions given to <u>Him</u> were also for <u>THEM</u>.

No one will be able to stand in your way: cf Deut 7:24 In Deuteronomy Moses addressed the whole people – God repeats it now to Joshua when he needs to hear it again. cf Acts 18:9-10

For us: This is even more true: Jesus addressed the WHOLE New People of God in Mt 28:28

"And behold, I am with you always... even to the end of the age": Acts 2:39

Mt 18:20 "For when 2 or 3 gather in my name I am there in the midst of them" cf Heb 13:5-7

"The Lord Himself is my Helper": Ps 118:6

Rom 8:31 "If God is FOR us, who can be against us?"

- God's promise to those who proclaim His Word and teach His Word: Ex 4:12 "I will help you and teach you what to say".
- Since God <u>alone</u> knows the obstacles ahead of us, He <u>alone</u> can support us and encourage us and He alone can bring us through to victory.
- These assurances are given to Joshua and to us because the times ahead will be very challenging.
 - The enemies waiting for Joshua were <u>THE SAME</u> as those that the 10 spies <u>refused</u> to face back in Num 14.
 - We gain nothing by running away from our issues we merely delay our stay in the wilderness and
 we <u>must</u> at some stage face our giants if we are to take <u>POSSESSION</u> of the Holy Will of God,
 which brings all happiness with it.
 - Only when we are armed with the Divine Will and the Divine Word can we have the Victory over our "demons" our inner challenges.
 - So, we are up against our issues <u>and</u> the demonic forces who want us <u>To Fail!</u>
 So, we need to be <u>RESOLUTE</u> and have courage and fortitude to take to the "Narrow Way":
 Mt 7:13-14
 - (NB) To achieve victory we must give **Primacy** to **obedience** and God's Will and God's Word.
 - For the great task ahead, it is more important to realise that we have the Presence and Power of God with us... than to look at the problems.
 - Our choice: magnify the problem (by looking down \downarrow) or magnify the Lord (by looking up \uparrow).

Response to God: Obedience 1:10-18

1:10 <u>Perfect Obedience!</u> He put God's Word into action. He didn't call a <u>Conference</u> to discuss what to do. cf St Paul after his conversion: Gal 1:16 "I conferred not with flesh and blood" Paul put God's message into action also. Procrastination is not the way of the saints.

Ps 119:32 "I run in the path of your commandments for you have set my heart free"
Heb ch 3-4 "Today if you hear his voice do not harden your hearts"
Heb 10:7 Jesus' position: "Behold I come to do your Will, Oh Lord!"

- Notice that Joshua used his God-given authority to direct the leaders...
- Notice Paul's advice to Titus a younger teacher/leader.
 Titus 2:15: "These are the things you should teach. Encourage and rebuke with all authority.
 Do not let anyone despise you"
 - <u>So</u> the new teacher/leader must <u>use</u> the authority given to them by God; otherwise there will be no growth or development in anyone teacher or students.
 - Mt 7:28-29 tells us that Jesus' teaching made a deep impression on the people BECAUSE
 He taught with authority... not like the Scribes... leaning on the opinions of other
 teachers (Rabbis!)
- "Get provisions ready" For in 3 days you will cross the Jordan... on the 3rd Day!

 The 3rd day is God's day Victory Day resurrection day... the day on which the miracle of the Manna will <u>STOP FOREVER!</u> The wilderness journey will be <u>over</u> at long last.
 - They will from then on be known as **THE PEOPLE** of **THE LAND.**

- **Today We** have been warned to make provision for dreadful future events. We must be ready and "Go with God" wherever He sends us / or takes us.
- **Notice** They were going to cross the Jordan River yet Joshua didn't tell them to prepare **BOATS** or **RAFTS** to carry the old / sick / young! No! All they needed was **VIATECUM**: food for the journey.
 - For the challenges ahead of us, then, all we need is: 1) Food of God's Word
 - 2) Food of Eucharist
 - 3) Food of God's Will
 - ... although the prophets have told us to get food for the body in also as Joshua did.
 - (NB) 1 Tim 6:12 Like Joshua and his people we, too, must "fight the good fight of the Lord"
 - Like him, too, we won't overcome any "Canaanites" unless we are in God's Divine Will.
 - We won't have true peace of conscience... or substantial rest in the soul or lasting joy in the heart
 <u>UNTIL</u> Rom 6:6 "our former selves have been crucified with him to destroy this sinful body and to
 free us from the slavery to sin"

And Col 3:1 we have been brought back to TRUE LIFE IN CHRIST"
This is what gives us the ability to speak and lead with authority.

- (NB) Laziness is lethal when one is faced with a long time of trials and difficulties as is facing us in **the Tribulation**. Absolute surrender to God is required... only total dependence on God will enable us to be His **good** servants in a world that has rejected Him.
- **1:12:18** Joshua insists on the 2½ tribes keeping their word to Moses regarding conquering Canaan before settling into the territories in Transjordania that they claimed for themselves.
